



2010 Salmon and You Program Registration

Salmon and You includes a 1 hour classroom presentation and a 3 hour guided field study investigation.

Classroom Presentation & Field Study Investigation (offered in the fall)

This program explores the lifecycle of salmon, provides hands-on experience with internal/external fish anatomy, identifies salmon habitat needs and limiting factors, and analyzes water quality. The 1 hour classroom presentation and 3 hour field study help students determine their local stream or rivers suitability for salmon as they investigate the health of the Walker/Miller Creek Watershed or Duwamish/Green River Watershed. Students also discover their impact on salmon habitat. The field study includes a large motor skills game. This program can be offered as a classroom only session.

Recommended Grades: 4-8

Program Details

Location: Classroom visits are held at your school.

Field trip locations:

1. Normandy Park Cove, the convergence site of the Walker/Miller Creek watershed
2. Cecil Moses State Park along the Green/Duwamish River

Busing: You need to arrange and pay for transportation for this field trip. It is helpful to register with another class.

Cost: \$50 for the 1 hour pre-trip class and \$200 for the 3 hour field study trip per each group of 30 kids for a total of \$250 for the program. If your school has 50 % or greater reduced or free lunch rate, your course fee may be waived (please request waiver).

Billing: An invoice will be sent upon scheduling the course.

Materials Cost: If ESC delivers more than one program to a class that qualifies for free ESC courses in the school semester; then a \$25 materials fee will be charged per class.

Chaperones: During the field study, we would like students put into groups of 10-12 with two school provided chaperones for each group.
