



Water Heroes Program Registration

Water Heroes program includes a 1.5 hour classroom presentation and a 1.5 hour guided field study investigation.

Water Heroes: Classroom Presentation & Field Study Investigation

This program introduces students to the watershed system. The 1.5 hour classroom presentation uses an interactive PowerPoint presentation and group game to discover components of a healthy watershed and water cycle. The 1.5 hour field study investigation takes students to a local water feature such as Walker Creek or Angle Lake to test water quality and identify living and non-living elements present. All three focus areas can be offered as a classroom only session.

Teachers will choose from three focus areas:

- 1: **“What Is A Watershed?”**- Explore the concept of a watershed; identify your local watershed and examine indicators of watershed health. (Grades K-2)
- 2: **“Where Is Your Water Going?”**- Examine the difference between a sewer and storm drain; identify street run-off, sustainable uses of a watershed, and examples of watershed restoration. (Grades 2-5)
- 3: **“From the Mountains to the Sound!”**- Follow the journey of a salmon; identify biotic relationships in your local watershed and illustrate the importance of watershed stewardship practices. (Grades 6-12)

All three focus areas can be delivered as a classroom only session.

Grades: K-12

Program Details

Location: Classroom visits are held at your school

Field trip locations: 1. Walker Creek or 2. Angle Lake

Busing: You need to arrange and pay for transportation for this field trip. It is helpful to register with another class.

Cost: \$75 for the 1.5 hour classroom presentation and \$150 for the 1.5 hour field study investigation. Total program cost is \$225 per class. If your school has 50 % or greater reduced or free lunch rate your course fee may be waived (please request waiver).

Billing: An invoice will be sent upon scheduling the course.

Materials Cost: If ESC delivers more than one program to a class that qualifies for free ESC courses in the school semester; then a \$25 materials fee will be charged per class.

Chaperones: During the field study, we would like students put into groups of 10-12 with two school provided chaperones for each group.
